Ballroom Dancing / Line Dancing

Learn any of a variety of social or recreational dances performed by couples, as in a ballroom. Line dancing is a form of dancing performed by rows of people to country and western music.

Book Club (Middle School Students Only)

Share or swap easy-to-make recipes. Each month a recipe will be emailed to students & each student will be responsible for bringing in an ingredient from that recipe. Students will be responsible for bringing the recipe to life (extent of actual cooking will involve using a microwave or crock pot). 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Health and Fitness Club
