

SEMESTER EXAMS

Middle School

- All Middle School students will take mid-year exams in English, Social Studies, Science, and Math. The mid-year exam grade will appear in the exam column of the report card for semester 1.
- Dismissal is at 11:30 a.m. on exam days. No US lunch is served on exam days.
- On Friday, December 17, Middle School students **are not** required to come to school unless they have a make-up test/exam.

High School

- Mid-year exams are scheduled for English, Social Studies, Science, Math, and Spanish. The mid-year exam grade will appear in the exam column of the report card for semester 1.
- All students will be dismissed at 11:30 a.m. on exam days.
- On Friday, December 17, parents may pick up HS students in car line after the Spanish exam (at 9:50 a.m.) if no make-up exam is scheduled.
- Exam Exemption guidelines for senior exams are listed below. There are no exceptions to the exemption rules.

Please make sure your child is at school on-time, arriving no later than 8:00 a.m. Testing episodes will begin on time. **Tardy students will not be given additional time to complete exams.** Room assignments for testing will be emailed to students/parents and posted the morning of each exam. **All students are required to stay in the testing room until the end of the exam period.** Students who do not have an exam will go to a study hall. No upper school lunch is served on exam days. Extended Care is available on Wednesday and Thursday only for grades K-8.

Mid-Year Exam Exemption Privilege - APPLIES FOR AMERICAN GOVERNMENT STANDARD/HONORS ONLY.

High school students may exempt from the **American Government Standard/Honors Mid-Year Exam** provided they meet the following qualifying criteria:

- Student must have a 90% or higher average for Quarters 1 & 2 in the exempted class. No in-school or out-of-school suspensions during the semester
- No more than ten (10) absences (excused or unexcused) for semester 1 in any exam exempted class. **Please note- 3 tardies (excused or unexcused) equals 1 absence.**
- Community service hours (cumulative 75 hours for seniors) completed and turned in by deadline date of December 1, 2021. (Reminder- 100 cumulative hours are required for graduation)
- Exam Exemption Form must be completed, signed by teacher, and turned in by due date – December 10, 2021.
- Qualifying students have the option of taking the mid-year exam(s) to improve their semester average(s). If taken, the exam(s) will be included in the first semester average.
- The HS Mid-Year Exam Exemption Form will be available from the teacher or US office beginning Dec. 8, 2021. Forms must be properly completed and turned in to the US office by the Dec. 10, 2021, deadline date. No forms will be accepted after the deadline.
- **Exemption does not apply to students taking American Government S or H on FLVS.**

★ **Qualifying students have the option of taking the mid-year exam(s) to improve their semester average(s). If taken, the exam(s) will be included in the semester 1 average.**
