

# 1<sup>st</sup> – 5<sup>th</sup> Grade

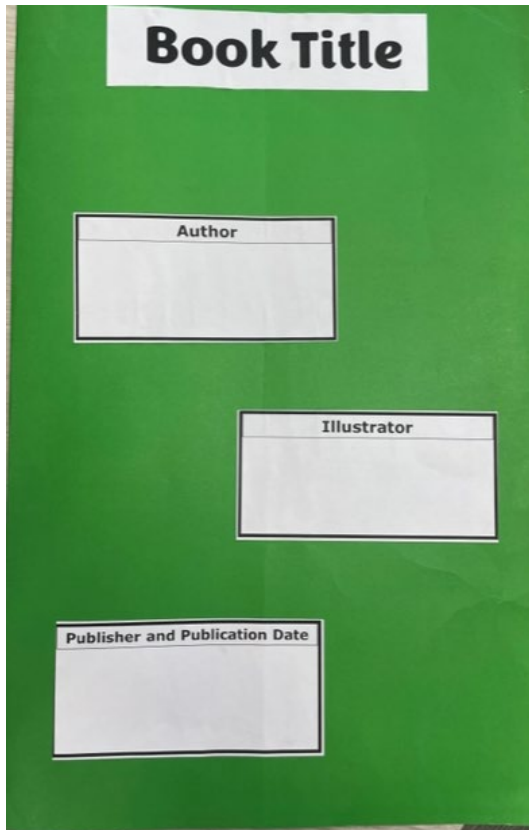
## Required Summer Reading Project

Due the 1<sup>st</sup> day of school, August 9<sup>th</sup>, for a test grade

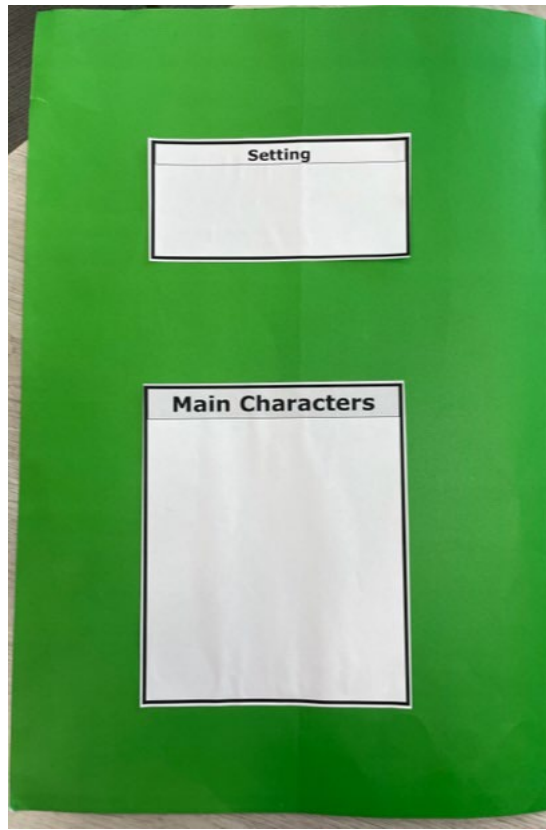
1. Read both Summer Reading books required for your grade level.
2. Choose **1** book for your project.
3. Print out pages 3-8 of this document. Have your student hand-write the information in each box. NO typed papers.
  - a. **Author:** Write their first and last name.
  - b. **Illustrator:** Write their first and last name if known.
  - c. **Publisher and Publication Date:** Write the Publisher's name and date.
  - d. **Setting:** Write the **place** and **time** of the story in a complete sentence.
  - e. **Main Characters:** Write the name of no more than 4 main characters and a brief description of each one.
  - f. **Problem:** State the story's problem in a complete sentence.
  - g. **Solution:** Describe how the problem was solved in a complete sentence.
  - h. **Plot Summary:** Write a summary of the story.
  - i. **Blank Page:** Draw a picture related to the story.
4. Use one piece of poster board (22 X 28) in any color. Fold it in half to make a book.
5. Once the student has hand-written their answers on the Project Pages, cut them out and glue them to the poster board. Use the example photo on page 2 of this document as your placement guide.
  - a. **Front Cover:** Book Title, Author, Illustrator, Publisher, and Publisher Date
  - b. **Inside Left side:** Setting & Main Characters
  - c. **Inside Right side:** Problem, Solution, & Plot Summary
  - d. **Back Cover:** Drawing, Student's Name and Grade
6. Please feel free to be creative. (Examples: adding trim, borders, cut outs, etc.)

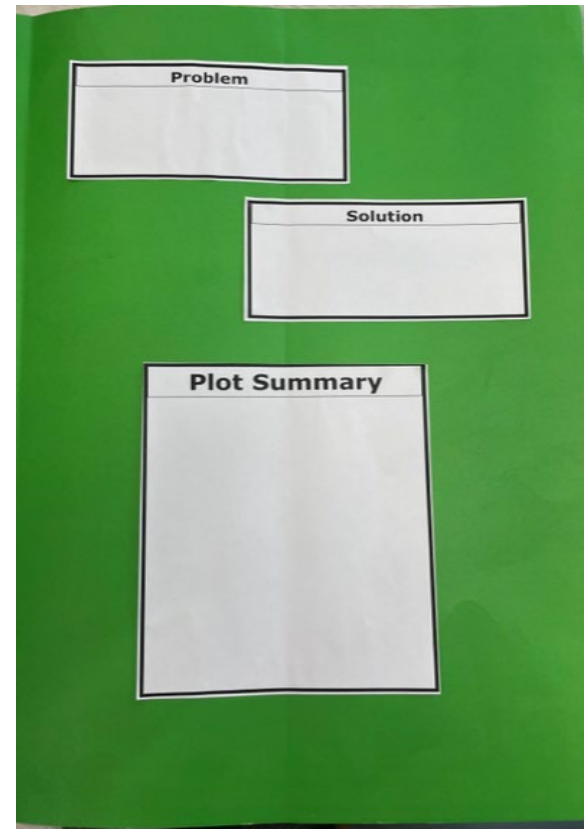
