CLASS RULES AND EXPECTATIONS

HOW, WHY, AND WHAT I TEACH

2 Timothy 2:24-25

The How

v. 24 “And the Lord’s servant must not be quarrelsome, but a gentle listener and teacher who keeps cool, working firmly but patiently with those who refuse to obey.”

The Why

v.25 “correcting with gentleness as you never know how or when God might sober them up with a change of heart (repentance) leading them to a knowledge of the truth.”

The What- The Gospel

1 Corinthians 15:3-4

v.3 “For I delivered to you as of first importance what I also received: that Christ died for our sins in accordance with the Scriptures, v.4 that He was buried, that He was raised on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures.”

WHAT WE DO IN CLASS...

- **Monday and Tuesday-** Typically use the entire class period to teach the principle, doctrine, or topic we are covering. Students are expected to take notes.
- **Wednesday-** Use questions/prompts to help promote lively class discussion, Q&A time, or resource reinforcement (video, podcast, etc...) of weekly topic.
- **Thursday-** Typically quiz or test day over our weekly passage and/or our truth for the week. Starting second nine weeks each table of students will be responsible for sharing what they have learned and learning to defend their faith.
- **Friday-** Fun Friday. This our favorite day!
