PAYMENT CHOICES

We offer the following payment plans that are available for a minimal fee*. The **12-month plan** is scheduled from June 2024 through May 2025. The **Quarterly** payment plan is scheduled for July, October, January, and April. Tuition insurance of 2.0% is required for all monthly or quarterly payment plans and/or utilization of any scholarship or financial aid.

*Families will be charged a FACTS processing fee depending on the payment plan selected:

\$55.00 – Quarterly and monthly payment

*Other FACTS fees include return check fees as well as a set % fee per credit card transaction.
