



Eaglet's Summer Reading Principal's Challenge

Are you ready for a challenge? The **Summer Reading Principal's Challenge** is open to all students entering **1st through 5th** grade for the 2026–2027 school year. This challenge is recommended but *optional* for all students.

- **1st–2nd Grade:** Count **books** read **independently** that are on grade level (**graphic books are excluded**).
- **3rd–5th Grade:** Count **pages read in novels** that are on grade level or above (**graphic novels are excluded**).
 - Don't know a book's level? Try using apps such as **Book Scanner, Points Scan, Book Leveler**, or similar tools to scan the ISBN number and quickly determine the reading level.

Awards

- The top three students in **1st and 2nd grade** who read the most grade-level books in each grade will receive a special award from the principal.
- The top three students in **3rd, 4th, and 5th grade** who read the most pages (on grade-level or above grade level novels) in each grade will receive a special award from the principal.

As students complete their reading, record each book's title, reading level, and number of pages on the attached **Summer Reading Challenge Form**. The completed form is due to the homeroom teacher on the **first day of school**.

Books read for the Eaglet's Summer Reading Principal's Challenge may also count toward the Accelerated Reading (AR) program. AR quizzes will be available when students return to school in August.
