CCA HOMECOMING 2026 FAMILY & COMMUNITY GUIDE September 21–26, 2026

We are excited to celebrate Homecoming Week together as a CCA community! Below you will find the schedule of activities, dress-down themes, event information, and expectations for each day of Homecoming Week.

GENERAL HOMECOMING DRESS-DOWN GUIDELINES

The following guidelines apply to all Homecoming dress-down days:

- All apparel must be on theme for the designated dress-down day.
- If a student's dress does not align with the theme for the day, the student may be asked to change back into the standard CCA uniform.
- All clothing must be mission appropriate and should not be distracting to the learning environment.
- All bottoms must be fingertip length.
- Leggings, biker shorts, and other tight-fitting clothing are not permitted.
- Shirts and tops must fully cover the stomach, shoulders, chest, undergarments, and back.
- Bathing suits are not permitted.
- All shoes must be closed-toed with a firm back.
- Crocs, flip-flops, sandals, and Uggs are not permitted.
- Themed outerwear, including sweaters, quarter-zips, full-zips, and hoodies, is permitted.
- Hats are permitted inside the building.
- All other CCA dress code and grooming policies remain in effect unless otherwise specified.
- If a student chooses not to participate in a dress-down day, they must wear their standard CCA school uniform.

MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 21, 2026

The Homecoming Dance is open to all CCA students in grades 9–12.

Dance Begins: 7:00 p.m.

Student Dismissal Begins: 9:30 p.m.

Dance Officially Ends: 10:00 p.m.

Students may be dismissed beginning at 9:30 p.m. The dance will officially conclude at 10:00 p.m. Once a student enters the dance, they will not be permitted to leave until 9:30pm. Students will not be allowed to go to and from their vehicle.

HOMECOMING DANCE GUESTS

CCA students are welcome to bring a guest who does not attend CCA to the Homecoming Dance. However, all non-CCA guests must be approved by school administration prior to the event.

Students wishing to bring a guest should:

1. Pick up a Homecoming Dance Guest Form from Mrs. Couch, our Upper School Administrative Assistant.
2. Complete the form with all required information.
3. Return the completed form to Mrs. Couch by the end of the school day on Friday, September 18, 2026.

Guests will not be permitted to attend without prior administrative approval.

HOMECOMING DANCE DRESS CODE

The Homecoming Dance is a semi-formal event. All students and approved guests are expected to dress in a manner that reflects CCA's mission, values, and standards of modesty.

GENTLEMEN'S GUIDELINES

All gentlemen should dress in semi-formal attire.

At a minimum, gentlemen should wear:

- A button-down shirt
- Slacks
- Either a coat or a tie
- Think "Sunday Best"

Additional expectations:

- All attire should be modest in nature.
- Sandals, tennis shoes, and Crocs are not permitted.
- Baggy pants are not permitted.
- Pants may not be worn too low. Pants should be worn at the natural waist, not at the hips.

LADIES' GUIDELINES

All ladies should dress in semi-formal attire.

Additional expectations:

- All dresses should be modest in nature.
- The hem of a dress or skirt must be no higher than fingertip length.
- For dresses or skirts with a slit, the slit must be no higher than fingertip length.
- Strapless dresses are not permitted.
- Dresses with one-shoulder straps are acceptable.
- Dresses with halter-style tops are acceptable.
- Clothing that is sheer, mesh or does not fully cover the stomach, lower back, cleavage, or undergarments is not permitted.
- All dresses must be approved prior to the dance.

DRESS APPROVAL PROCESS

All dresses must be approved by Mrs. Bonstein by the end of the school day on Friday, September 18, 2026. This requirement applies to both CCA students and non-CCA guests attending the Homecoming Dance.

For the approval process:

- A full-length picture of the student wearing the dress, including front and back views, must be submitted for approval.
- Pictures should show the student wearing the shoes or heels that will be worn to the dance.
- Photos may be emailed to Mrs. Bonstein at DBonstein@ccajax.org.
- In some instances, students may be asked to have their dress approved in person while wearing the shoes they plan to wear to the dance.

Students or guests will not be permitted to enter the Homecoming Dance if they are wearing a dress that has not been approved in advance.
